Most owners are surely aware of alligator safety. And if you have not noticed, they are very active this season. So, I wanted to take the opportunity to increase awareness about another kind of wildlife... sea turtles. You may have seen a special notice about sea turtle protection in the most recent issue of *The Anchor*. As you may know, Loggerhead sea turtle nesting season is from May through October across the South Carolina lowcountry. Never disturb a sea turtle nest or a hatchling. Please be careful with lights anywhere near the beach at night after 10pm. If you need to use a flashlight for beach walks, red ones are recommended. Also, please make an effort to return sand to its undisturbed state after building sandcastles or digging holes on the beach. And finally, place all trash in the appropriate receptacles. A BIG THANKS goes out to the Turtle Trackers (many of them Shipyard owners/residents) for all they do to protect indigenous wildlife. And thanks to all of you others for doing your part. We appreciate you!
