SMART 911 CHIEF ALEXANDER

Smart911 is a free, private and secure service where a safety profile you create can provide potentially life-saving information to emergency responders when they need it most. Once a safety profile is created, it immediately displays to the 911 dispatcher when a call is placed to 911 from that particular phone number.

The profile allows you to add as little or as much information as you want, but it is recommended to add any details you would want responders to know if you do have an emergency - like medical conditions, medications, elderly family members that may be prone to wandering, photos of yourself or children or pets.
