



...Severe Thunderstorms Possible This Afternoon...

OVERVIEW:

Thunderstorms are expected to develop ahead of an approaching cold front this afternoon and move across southeast Georgia and southeast South Carolina. A few of these thunderstorms could become severe, with the primary threat being damaging wind gusts.
