Greetings owners! As the weather continues to warm up, we hope you are making plans to enjoy the beach and many of the new events we have scheduled for you. Below are a few reminders as we approach the Memorial Day and summer spike:

• Beach Updates

Beach Hangtags - Hangtags will be required for the beach access area parking effective May 27th at 8am. This also includes the overflow parking area. Please take a moment to pick yours up if you have not already done so. Limited to one per household.

Beach Locker Updates - New letter updates on your waitlist status are being mailed out the first week of May. Please check your mailboxes the following weeks to make sure you receive one.

Turtle Time - It's turtle season! Loggerhead turtles start nesting on May 1st. Please help us protect this endangered species. Learn more at seaturtlepatrolhi.org.

Bike Safety - Please walk your bikes on the way to the beach. The walkway is heavily traveled in the spring and summer months. Do your part in keeping it safe and enjoyable for everyone by walking your bikes in the beach area.

• ***NEW THIS MONTH*-Open Deck Days at the Beach Club (Typically on the 1st Thursday of each month from 12-9pm)** - There was a good turnout for the first Deck Day on 4/7, but we are hoping to see even more of you on 5/12 and 6/2! Bring food and beverages with you, or even some games.

• **Request Passes Online** - Expecting visitors? The easiest way to request passes is via our online portal on the POA website. For last minute requests (under 2 hours), calling in passes via the gatehouses is still the best method to ensure that the pass is ready for your guest.

• **Emergency Contact Forms** - Thanks to those of you who have submitted an updated Emergency Contact Form. However, hurricane season (beginning 6/1) is just around the corner. We still need your help in trying to ensure that we have the most up-to-date contact information in the event of a storm. Forms are available at the Welcome Center, or on the POA website.

• **Gate Access** - The POA Team is working harder than ever to ensure smoother operations over the busy tourist months. One of our primary goals is to reduce wait times at the gates via a trial system. This trial system, slated to begin on May 15th, is geared toward requiring rental and timeshare management company teams to pick-up and distribute passes to their guests off property as opposed to hundreds of guests picking them up at the gates during peak times. Hopefully these efforts will help alleviate time at the gates. Also, the Board of Directors is currently reviewing options for electronic owner's gates. We will share more information with you as it becomes available, but there will probably not be any significant activity until the fall. We just wanted you all to know that we are working on ways to make the access experience more pleasant, efficient, and practical for all.
