
1. All e-blast emails (2+ per week)

The Shipyard Security Team has launched the national #9PMRoutine and exclusive #ShipyardSafe campaigns. The #9PM routine is a reminder to remove valuables from your vehicles, lock your vehicle doors, lock the doors to your homes, turn on exterior lights and activate all alarms and security systems. Over the summer, we will send out a weekly reminder around 9pm!

Criminals look for easy targets. Many vehicle burglaries, and to a lesser degree, stolen vehicles, occur as a result of vehicles being left unlocked. The best way to prevent vehicle burglaries is to remove all of your valuables, lock your vehicle's doors upon exiting, and take the keys to the vehicle inside your residence.

Beach Locker Renters - Please make every effort to keep your locker locked, even while you are using your contents. When owners or their guests forget to secure lockers, it is common for weekly renters/interval owners to use them for various amounts of time. Of course, this is strictly prohibited. But more importantly, it results in staff emptying contents that belong to unapproved parties and causing confusion and frustration among owners/guests. Also, it is a good idea to keep your unit locked to prevent guests from borrowing or taking your personal items. Finally, please do not stage any items in the walkways in the locker area. We want to keep these areas free and clear of trip hazards and maintain it in an orderly fashion.

Beach Hangtags - Until Labor Day weekend, your beach hangtag is required when parking to use the beach. **One per household.**

4TH OF JULY WEEKEND TIPS:

- ❖ When driving, observe speed limits and follow the rules of the road.
- ❖ If you plan on drinking alcohol, designate a driver who won't drink or use a taxi company (Uber or Lyft).
- ❖ Keep your grill clean and never add fluids after coals are lit.
- ❖ Place the grill away from the house (about 10 feet), trees, or branches.
- ❖ Allow grill to cool before moving.
- ❖ If you are enjoying the beach, please actively supervise children.
- ❖ Drink plenty of water!
- ❖ When leaving the beach, make sure to fill in all holes in the sand and take any trash with you.
- ❖ **Firecrackers, sparkers, etc. are not allowed within Shipyard.**
