
Lets talk about **roundabouts**, also known as traffic circles. Many of us who live in the Lowcountry full time or visit often are very familiar with how these things work! Roundabouts are designed to make intersections safer and more efficient for drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists. There are two basic types of roundabouts: single-lane and multi-lane.

There are a few key things to remember about driving through roundabouts:

- Slow down when approaching
- Yield to drivers already in the roundabout (on the circulating roadway)
- Pick a lane and stay there; do not change lanes
- Do not stop in the roundabout

- If you are currently renting a Beach Locker, you should've received an invoice for your beach locker via mail in November 2022. If you intended on continuing your rental, your payments are past due. At this time, if you have not made your locker payment, your contents and lock have been removed. Keep in mind beach lockers are nontransferable.
- If you are patiently waiting on the beach locker waitlist, you should receive a letter in the mail with an updated status. Once a locker becomes available and you are next in line, you will be contacted via phone. At this point you will be expected to pay the annual rate and will be issued a locker number. Please provide your own beach supplies and lock.
