For the new and seasoned owners, the Shipyard Security Team is going to continue implementing the national **#9PMRoutine** and exclusive **#ShipyardSafe** campaigns. The #9PM routine is a reminder to remove valuables from your vehicles, lock your vehicle doors, lock the doors to your homes, turn on exterior lights and activate all alarms and security systems. Each month, we will send out a reminder around 9pm!

Criminals look for easy targets. Many vehicle burglaries, and to a lesser degree, stolen vehicles, occur as a result of vehicles being left unlocked. The best way to prevent vehicle burglaries is to remove all of your valuables, lock your vehicle's doors upon exiting, and take the keys to the vehicle inside your residence.
